# **Cooking Class**

## Artisans d'Angkor

Artisans d'Angkor teaches wood- and stone-carving techniques, traditional silk painting, lacquer ware and other artisan skills to impoverished young Cambodians. Free guided tours explaining traditional techniques are available daily from 7.30am to 6.30pm.

### Silk farm (Artisans d'Angkor)

Artisans d'Angkor maintains a silk farm, which produces some of the best work in the country, including clothing, interior-design products and accessories. All stages of the production process can be seen here, from the cultivation of mulberry trees through the nurturing of silk worms to the dyeing and weaving of silk. Free tours are available daily from 7.30am to 6.30pm.

#### Senteurs d'Angkor

Senteurs d'Angkor's botanic garden is a sort of Willy Wonka's for the senses, where you can sample infused teas and specialty coffees.

## **Ceramic Fine Art center**

This ceramics center is dedicated to reviving the Khmer tradition of pottery, which was an intricate art during the time of Angkor. Free tours are available, including formation on Angkorian techniques and a new museum.

#### **Stocker Lacquer**

A nice villa in a small street of Siem Reap is where Angkor Artwork makes the most beautiful lacquerware. A visit to the lacquer workshop, tucked in the shaded garden is a wonderful experience.
