## Traditional local dance, Apsara dance

No visit to Cambodia is complete without at least a quick glimpse of women performing the ancient art of Apsara dance, as depicted on the walls of Angkor's temples. Wearing glittering silk tunics, sequined tops (into which they are sewn before each performance to achieve the requisite tight fit) and elaborate golden headdresses, performers execute their movements with definess and deliberation, knees bent in plié, heels touching the floor first at each step, coy smiles on their faces

Pub Street is packed with many different food and beverage carts, varying from banana pancakes to different exotic fruit shakes. There are also a lot of places where you can buy Cambodian art pieces, clothing etc. It is also ideal for a night out of bar shopping with like-minded travelers as its numerous bars are easily accessible on foot while unique cocktails and beers cost only US\$1 (or less) during happy hour
